

VISUAL ART TERM 2 2017

The theme for the term is 'Our Story',

Foundation: Students will have the opportunity to explore their story through focusing on family and the places they come from, picture story books and the art made by the Indigenous people of Australia. They will explore art made on cave walls and other Indigenous art.

Year 1: Students will have the opportunity to learn about line and shape by drawing toys from the past and now, to integrate with their history unit. They will explore Australia's story through Indigenous art and how it tells stories that are passed down.

Year 2: Students will have the opportunity to explore historical family portraits before creating their own. They will explore Indigenous art and how it tells stories that are passed down through generations.

Year 3: Students will have the opportunity to explore how their local and wider community has changed over time. They will also look at the 'Australian story' through literature and Indigenous art.

Year 4: Students will have the opportunity to explore the history of Australia through artworks that tell a story about explorers, Indigenous people and colonization.

Year 5: Students will have the opportunity to learn about Colonial times in Australia through exploring art of the Gold Rush to visualize and create places and people of that time in Australian history.

Year 6: Students will have the opportunity to develop their understanding of the many people who have come to Australia that make it the nation it is today. They will view items and art by refugees to gain an insight into their experiences and to inspire artworks.
